1. Scoring system for upper airways:

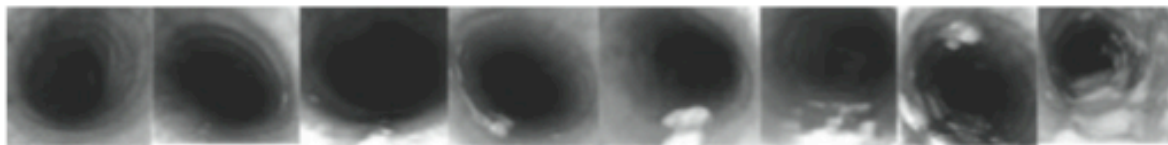
Pharyngitis: Grade I - IV

Pharyngeal Mucus Accumulation: Score 0 - 2

2. Scoring system for lower airways:

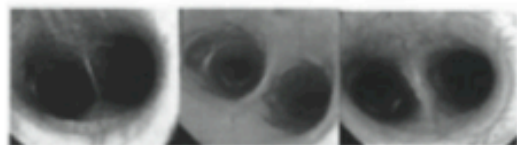
Trachea Mucus Accumulation: Score 0 - 5

Bronchial Mucus Accumulation: Score 0 - 5
