



Dolphin and Union Caribou sample kit

1) BLOOD ON FILTER PAPER (as soon as the animal is killed)

BAG

envelope



All strips directly frozen ot soaked Dry at the air

3) DROPPINGS from the butt




INTO CLEAR BAG

4) LIVER piece of 2x2 inches (5x5 cm)



INTO CLEAR BAG


5) LEFT WHOLE KIDNEY with fat



6) FRONT TEETH




7) MEASURE BACKFAT



Measure backfat using the ruler on the **TAG**




