
























Droppings from the butt (not from the ground)



Left hind leg










#### **HOW TO COLLECT THE SAMPLES**

1) BLOOD ON FILTER PAPER (as soon as the animal is killed)






All strips soaked

Dry at the air



Close the envelope





3) DROPPINGS from the butt




INTO CLEAR BAG

4) LIVER piece of 2x2 inches (5x5 cm)



INTO CLEAR BAG

5) LEFT WHOLE KIDNEY with fat




6) LEFT HIND LEG (with skin and hoof)



7) JAW TAG






